When Pigs Fly

In 2015, as we approached HONEST JOHN'S FINTASTIC CHILI COOK-OFF, I had every intention of being there and competing, until I realized the chili cook-off at the Caddy Corner in Justin, Texas, was exactly the same day my Blue Tick Hound, Sarah, was due to whelp. I wasn't comfortable driving her to Texas from Arizona in her delicate condition, to have her pups, so I called Honest John and gave my regrets. I promised I would be there for sure next year to compete with my world famous squirrel chili. I had noticed there is an "exotic chili" award and I was confident I could win it. I was assured there were abundance of squirrels in the area. Well ... Sarah had eleven pups, five girls and six boys right on her due date. Them dogs will hunt ...

As the 2016 FINTASTIC CHILI COOK-OFF approached, I was somewhat anxious because it was my first and I didn't really know what to expect. I went north out of Fort Worth on 156 like I was supposed to and west on 407 like I was supposed to. If you pass "MOM'S" cafe on the left, then you know you are on the right road. BUT don't stop. You will stay and ruin your appetite for the rest of the day for chili tasting. Some say, maybe it's the best restaurant cookin' in that part of Texas ...

OH MY GOODNESS ... This must be it. Those pastures on the left are not occupied by grazing Santa Gertrudis, Brangus, Beefmasters or Charolais. These pastures are filled with more Cadillacs than I have ever seen in one place. From the forties to the eighties, and as the day wore on, right up past the turn of the century into the "twenties" as Doug Ashby's beautiful '06 XLR was likely the most recently to be assembled.

I thought I had plenty of time at eight a.m. on that beautiful Saturday morning. I loaded my granddaddy's Winchester and lit out to find the squirrels for my chili. I had carefully packed and brought everything else I needed for my chili from home. Perfect morning ... according to the rules set by Honest John, prep could not begin before 11:00 a.m. and turn in for judging was at 3:00 p.m. Still plenty of time... BUT... Somebody must have got a word out that I was comin', because I saw nary a squirrel for two hours. I really needed three of these critters, because they don't have much meat on them, but I could get by with two ... BUT I didn't even get a shot at one ... Didn't even see one. I was so sure of myself, I didn't have a plan "B." Nigh onto Ten o'clock and panic was starting to set in. When I get into a fix at home, Walmart usually bails me out, so why shouldn't it work in Texas. It did. I scrambled to Walmart in Denton and got four pounds of Angus chuck and back to Honest John's in time to start my preparations almost on time.

I think everyone but me were veterans of this chili cook-off and all had their territory staked out with level surfaces and pretty sanitary spaces and were busy cutting up stuff and throwing it in pots with various kinds of heat. John brought out an eight-foot folding banquet table and strung several extension cords from the barn and I had electric for my crock pot, so I turned it on high and started throwing cut up Walla Walla tomatoes, green jalapenos, and my secret mix of spices that I brought from home. Lifer gave me a propane cooker to braise the chuck I diced up, and Donna provided her good cast iron skillet, so my "squirrel" meat got done enough to put in with the mix in the pot. Now, just stir every once in a while and pray this stuff gets done by 3:00 p.m.

This being the 11th annual HONEST JOHN'S FINTASTIC CHILI COOK-OFF, most of those who entered had this down to a science, but anyone who forgot something had no worries, because there were ample emergency provisions for the taking in the inside prep area. Our hosts thought of everything.

I would have probably been very happy just to have walked the rows of Cadillac's all day, a true Cadillac parts haven with examples being shipped throughout the world from this Texas pasture. But not today. John and Donna Foust, their staff and friends were there to entertain, feed and spoil. Registration of show cars and chili cooks was efficient. The professional awards constructed by John Foust and staff were as fine as any concours event you have attended. The weather was perfect, but what I will remember for a lifetime were the new North Texas Cadillac club friends I met that day.

Others will write about this event and fill in details but, I just want to say what really blew me away was the preparation of the "HUBCAP CHILI TEAM from Lewisville, Texas. Emma Jean and Denna put together as fine a chili kitchen outdoors as you will ever see. Red and white checkered table cloth on up. Fresh vegetables of all colors, chili ingredients, flowers, matching aprons, chili cooking in the pot, topped off with live CLASSIC COUNTRY MUSIC - the kind most stations won't even play anymore. It doesn't get any better than that!



Oh yes ... My chili got done ... My chili got judged ... And my chili got an award ...


