


#### Paul Dixon writes:

**FEATURE ARTICLE - TOURING AMERICA in 1957.** Our fabulous photo journey continues! The back-story is that recently, Aucklander, Rex Findlay sent me a splendid article titled 'Touring America in 1957'. This is another part with a couple more photos and captions, all self-explanatory. Like all good photos, a great picture can 'tell a thousands words' so let the pictures do the talking! Great memories in colour as we look at when 'those were the days! [Cannot see any smog! - Ed]

In the blazing heat of Southern Nevada, the gambling mecca of Las Vegas began to sprout its roots and grow. Sin City was no longer confined to the downtown Fremont Street gambling parlors, The Las Vegas Strip became home to high rise resorts, with star entertainment, huge swimming pools, and fancy restaurants. Ignited by Bugsy Siegel's Flamingo, the strip exploded with new places like the Dunes, the Sands, and the Riviera. People loved seeing the antics of Dean Martin, Frank Sinatra, Sammy Davis, Jr., Joey Bishop and ad hoc members of their impromptu show. By 1957 they were known as the Rat Pack.

Before the days of parking structures, people left their cars out in the blazing heat of asphalt parking lots. Second degree burns were not unusual when unsuspecting tourists from cooler climes left their money in the slot machines and grabbed for the door handles of their cars to leave. Gambling fever swept the country after Las Vegas became a national tourist destination. One story tells of a man who was asked how he did at the tables. "Great!" he said, "I got here in a \$4000 Cadillac and I'm leaving on a \$30,000 bus."



Most Cadillac (and old car, for that matter) people are also into Elvis, music, memoroblia, petrolina and the like. Recently it was the 45th Anniversary of Elvis' passing. Where and what were you doing in 1977? Of late, we have witnessed the passing of several other BIG music greats. Interestingly enough, all those mentioned here (except Diana) have an association with Australia or NZ. How amazing and what a loss - Fd

Elvis Presley was only 42 years old when he was found dead in his Graceland Mansion on August 16, 1977

John Denver Grenell, who began a long and successful

musical career as John Hore, is remembered for his rich, velvet voice and humble personality. After suffering several strokes, Grenell developed dementia and spent the last few years in care, still enjoying singing along with his auitar and visiting the farm when possible. He is remembered by the writer for his rendition of Jim Reeves in a special tribute show that I attended here in Tauranga. He was dressed and appeared just like 'Gentleman Jim'. I understand the idea for the show came as a result of Jim's famous 'Welcome to my World' song that John Grenell sung on a NZ Toyota ad!



And Margaret Urlich, a terrific Kiwi icon from the 1980s on who is remembered for her part in Kiwi groups, 'Peking Man', 'When the Cats Away' (all girl group) and her famous solo work where she achieved platinum record sales status and her most famous single was 'Escapina' that reached Number One in NZ.

Then there is Judith Durham of Seekers fame; Australian singing great and vocalist of the Seekers, has died aged 79. Durham released a number of solo albums but was best known as the voice of folk music group the

Seekers, who she performed with from 1963 until 1968, when she left to pursue a solo career. The band quickly rocketed to worldwide success and sold more than 50m records, with a number of international hits including I'll Never Find Another You, The Carnival is Over, A World of Our Own and Georgy Girl. Like many, we had the Seekers vinyl at home and it got a good thrashing on my Sanyo portable record player! They were my old Mums favourite group! Judith and her group were the folksy sound of the sixties just like 'Peter, Paul and Mary' but only the Seekers were from 'down under!





Finally, it is the 25th Anniversary of Princess Diana's untimely death. Amazing to think, 25 years ago on 31 August 1997.



Olivia Newton-John was once described as having a voice of an angel. She is megafamous for her many, many music chartbusters (including 'Physical', 'Have you ever been mellow'; 'I honestly love you' and many more) and her films which also spun off even more famous songs. Her roles in the Grease and Xanadu movies made for great memorable viewing guaranteeing her never to be forgotten for years to come with re-runs likely to be shown on our TV channels! She was also a great supporter and founder of Cancer programs. She suffered from the 'big C' herself for nearly three decades. The Grease photo below is very befitting don't you think?


