UPDATE

Maryland Bill to Create Special Vintage Reproduction License Plate Signed Into Law

Legislation to require the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to provide, for one year, a specially designed vintage reproduction registration plate to qualifying vehicle owners was signed into law by Governor Martin O'Malley. Under the new law, to be eligible to receive a vintage reproduction registration plate, the vehicle must be a Class A (passenger), Class E (small truck), Class L (historic), Class M (multipurpose), or Class N (street rod) vehicle. The vintage reproduction plate will be designed to resemble the 1910 Maryland registration plate, which has black lettering on a yellow background. The MVA estimates that the additional cost to obtain the plates would be \$20 and would take effect January 1, 2014. Thank you and congratulations to all who participated in supporting this bill!

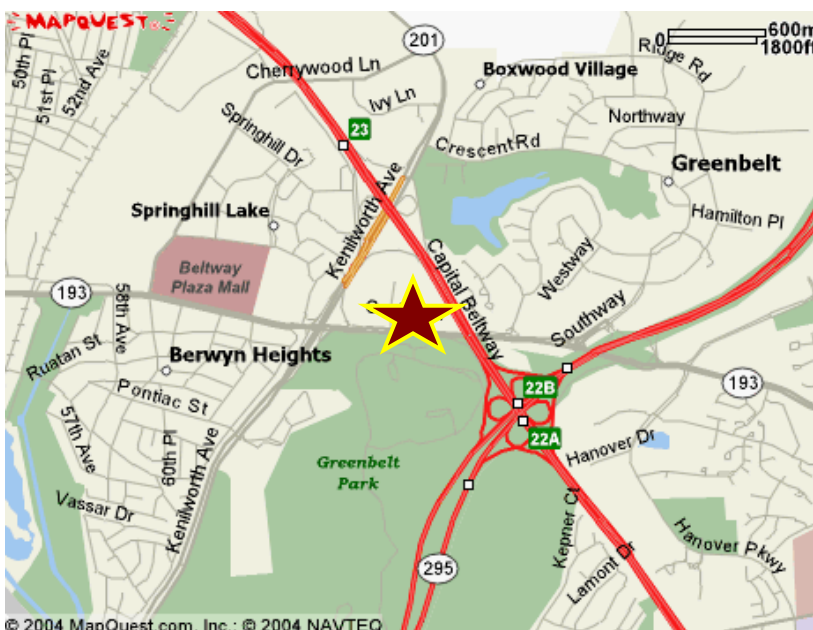
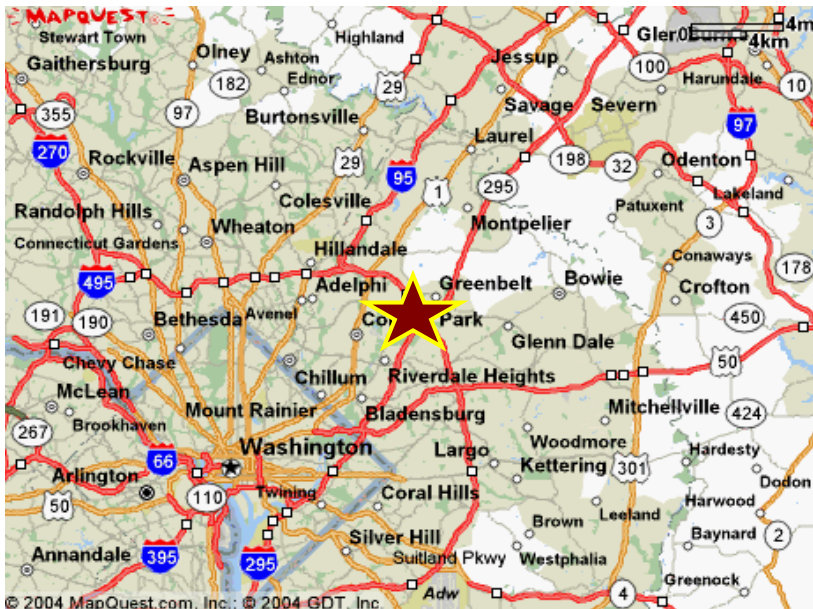

Car Show Rules

- **Rain or Shine:** The car show will take place rain or shine. No refunds.
- **Safety:** If a vehicle has fluid drips or leaks, the owner must bring absorbent material or drip pans to avoid slippery conditions and to protect the showroom floor or show field parking lot. **The Potomac Region reserves the right to prevent any cars with excessive fluid leaks from entering the show field.** It is recommended that a working fire extinguisher be in every vehicle.
- **Judging / Parking Rules:** The Potomac Region reserves the right 1) to determine each vehicle's judging class and 2) each vehicle's placement in the show field. **There will be no parking on the grassy areas whatsoever, due to sprinkler heads and possible rut damage.** Vehicles will be peer judged by the individual owners of the registered cars. Registrants will be able to judge vehicles in all classes, including their own. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards will be given to winning vehicles in each class.
- **Lunch Tickets:** Each registered car owner will receive one free lunch ticket. The lunch ticket will entitle the person to receive the following from **Red, Hot & Blue BBQ**, who will be on-site serving food:
 - 1) One Beef, Chicken or Pork Sandwich
 - 2) One Side order of Beans or Potato Salad and Cole Slaw
 - 3) One Drink including bottle waterAnyone without a lunch ticket will pay Red, Hot & Blue directly at the time of their purchase.

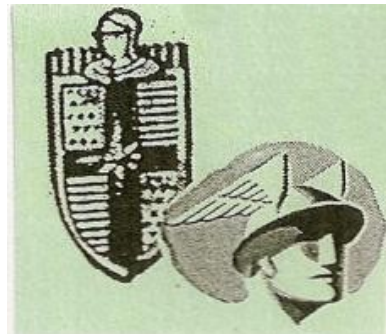

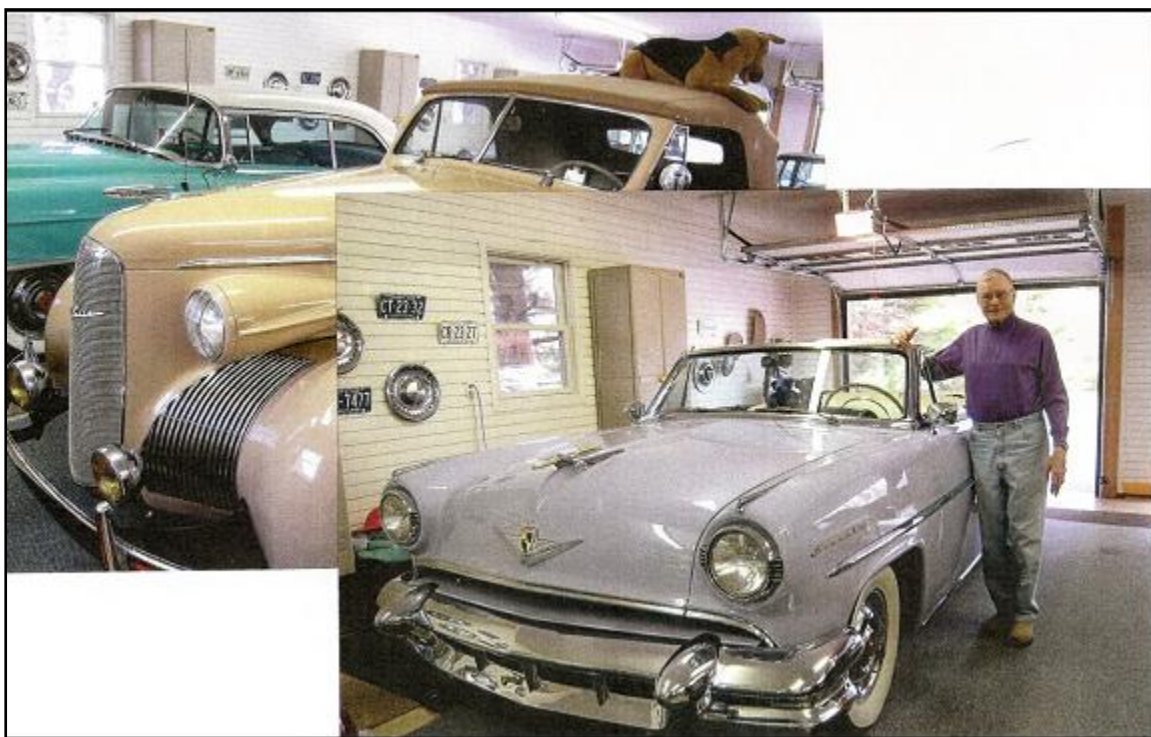

***"EVERY CAR HAS A STORY" - 1942 CADILLAC 7533 OWNED BY JEFF HANSEN

Along with Lynn Gardner, Debbie and I were fortunate to participate in the Valley Forge Region's (VFR) recent spring car show at General Sales Cadillac in West Chester, PA. Among the 33 cars there were some very magnificent specimens. But what really interested me, as I surveyed the many interesting cars, was the revelation that every one of these vehicles has a "story" – some better known than others.

This is the story of one of these vehicles, an absolutely magnificent 1942 7533 division window Imperial Sedan, owned by Jeff Hansen of Newark, DE. This stately gem was the first car for not only Jeff, but also his dad, dating to 1959.

The story of this rare Cadillac begins with its shipment from the factory on September 27, 1941, roughly nine weeks before Pearl Harbor, meaning it was an early build – #18 of only 430 7533's produced for the 1942 model year – a very rare car!

The car was delivered to the R.J. Schmunk Company in Cleveland, OH, the Cadillac distributor for that region. With the outbreak of war following the attack on Pearl Harbor on December 7th, unsold cars like Jeff's Cadillac were held by the US government for "allocation". Many were turned into military staff cars for senior officers. This 7533 stayed impounded until it was delivered on May 2, 1942 to Mr. H.A. Higgins, president of a local tool and die company supplying war materials. No doubt Mr. Higgins' direct involvement in building the "Arsenal of Democracy" played a part in the government rewarding him with the ability to purchase this magnificent car.

Mr. Higgins enjoyed his Imperial Sedan for only about two months, as he passed away in July, 1942. From there, the car had at least one additional owner until 1959, when Jeff's dad bought the car for \$50. Young Mr. Hansen had to have the car towed home because he was only 15 at the time and didn't have a driver's license. His father, Jeff's grandfather, held the title due to Jeff's dad's age.

Jeff's dad went about keeping the car on the road, and it transported him and his brother and friends to school. During Jeff's uncle's college years, it was known to handle frat house transit duties, often carrying 8-10 enthusiastic friends at a time (Jeff's uncle must have been a very popular guy in his fraternity). This role took its toll on the big 7533, and sometime in the late 1960's, it suffered a broken bronze idler gear in the flathead engine, taking it off the road. At that time, parts for a 27-year-old Cadillac were hard to come by.

By the time Jeff was 15-years-old, he became interested in the big, disabled Caddy and asked his grandfather (since he still held the title) if he could work on it. Grandpa conveyed that not only could he work on it, he could have it – something every 15-year-old wants to hear! Thus the big 7533 became a 2nd generation “1st car” in the same family.

Jeff went about doing all the research he could, and through his high school and college years, he never lost interest. He joined the CLC, and met a member in Pittsburgh, Tony Iezzi, who also owned a '42 7533. Tony's assistance and guidance proved crucial in keeping Jeff's interest and guiding what turned out to be a long-term, but very successful restoration.

From 1990 to 2005, Jeff did a complete restoration on his 7533, and has continued to enjoy its beauty and driving experience ever since. At the VFR Spring Show, the long labor of love continued to pay dividends, as everyone was very impressed with the quality of work and how smoothly and quietly that old 346 Flat Head engine ran! Jeff's car took “Best of Show – Prewar” category honors, and deservedly so.

Another car story....another tale involving passion, patience, and a fellow CLC member offering assistance! That's what our beloved hobby is all about.

**NEW MODELS DRIVING CADILLAC GROWTH:
CADILLAC SEDAN SALES RISE 109 PERCENT OVER PRIOR YEAR

DETROIT – Driven by the popularity of two new cars – the ATS and larger XTS – sales of Cadillac luxury sedans are up 109 percent compared to models the brand was selling a year ago. April was the 11th consecutive month of year-over-year retail sales gains.

Total U.S. sales for Cadillac were up 34 percent for April and 37 percent for the first four months of the year.



"The ATS sport sedan and XTS luxury sedan have significantly broadened our portfolio, and are attracting new buyers to Cadillac," said Chase Hawkins, vice president of Cadillac sales and service. "This growth is driving market share increases for the overall brand and in specific key segments."

The ATS sport sedan (pictured left) continued to bring in new customers from competitors. More than eight in 10 ATS buyers traded in something other than a Cadillac with most non-GM trade-ins coming from BMW, Audi and Lexus.

The XTS luxury sedan (pictured right) gained nearly a full percentage point of market share in April, despite deep incentive offers from luxury competitors. April was also XTS's best month for sales to individual customers since its launch.

Cadillac has been a leading luxury auto brand since 1902. Today Cadillac is growing globally, driven by an expanding product portfolio featuring dramatic design and technology.
