Right on County Road 511 or Greenwood Lake Tpk. toward West Milford. Drive 6.6 miles.

At fork in road (Greenwood Lake Sports Store is in middle) bear right onto Greenwood Lake Tpk.

Go 1.5 miles to fork. Bear right (actually straight) onto Warwick Turnpike. Go 1.6 miles.

Turn right at "Utopia Deli" onto Lakeshore Drive. Go 0.9 miles.


Shortly after Yardville Road (on left) will be #209 (also on the left), a beige ranch with cranberry shutters.


Four-Man Father's Day Show


