The Joliet Area Historical Museum had the high bid in the auction and paid a whopping \$275,000 to keep the iconic statue in Wilmington.

The Gemini Giant is currently in storage awaiting a new perch on Route 66 near the Kankakee River.

The Joliet Area Historical Museum is a great organization working to preserve local history along Route 66, including the Old Joliet Prison and the original Dairy Queen. They are a non-profit organization and all gifts are tax deductible; definitely worth remembering at gift giving time.




