# Pate Swap Meet Notes

.April 22, Saturday: On Setup Day the meeting time is 9:00-10:00 a.m. at the Cadillac & LaSalle Club-Pate Swap Meet hospitality tent at Andretti and Third Street in Zone 1A (the only tent up). There will be refreshments and water on hand. Be sure to sign the sign-in sheet. We pick up the golf carts and drive them over to the tent where the vendor space marker tile tubs and street sign cones are stored.

Tiles: Each golf cart is loaded up with the tile tubs for the zone that is being worked. Note that each cart can have a walkietalkie, water, and any other refreshments the cart occupant's desire. After laying the tiles, the tubs with maps and walky-talkies are returned to the hospitality tent and the golf carts are then returned to north of the dich near the HQ trailer before leaving. Leave cart keys in the carts when parking. They will be collected when we are done.

Signs: The sign crew will also have a cart and will load cones and maps. After posting the signs, return to the Conex to unload any leftover items and then drop off the cart at Petty and West Gate 3 by the HQ trailer before leaving.


Lunch: Individual clubs will make arraignments for their member for lunch.

April 30th Sunday: On Pickup Day we meet at 9:00 -10:00 a.m. at the Cadillac & LaSalle Club-Pate Swap Meet hospitality tent at Andretti Avenue and Third Street in Zone 1A. The swap meet will be winding down, so driving your car to the tent should not be a problem. Be sure to sign the sign-in sheet.

Golf carts will be provided for the activity. Each cart will load up with zone-specific tubs, rubber bands, maps, walkie-talkies, water, and refreshments as desired for tile pickup. A sign crew will use a cart to pick up sign cones. After the tiles are retrieved, they should be taken to the hospitality tent for final sorting. After sorting the tubs will be taken to the Conex in Zone Zero for storage. Sign materials are taken to the Conex for storage.

Golf Carts: Before you leave, the empty golf carts are to be dropped off at the HQ trailer at Petty and West Gate 3. Leave the keys in the carts.



#### IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS!

Results from CLC winter BOD meeting, January 28, 2023 Please take time to read all changes.

- With the approaching retirement of Mike and Nancy Book (April 15), the BOD approved hiring Cornerstone Registration, Maple Grove, MN, as our office and membership management company. They will assume official duties April 1, with a NEW mailing address, a NEW email address, and a NEW office phone number. More details and information in the upcoming days and weeks.
- Due to the transition of membership data and other pertinent information to a new website, it was decided and approved that there will be no attempt to produce a 2024 Membership Directory either electronically or printed. However, every effort will be made to offer for purchase a printed Membership Directory for 2025.
- 3. All membership dues were approved for a modest increase. All existing dues (excluding E-membership) will increase \$10.00 annually effective April 1. Lifetime membership, available to an existing member of 10 years, will increase to \$1,250 domestically and \$1,500 other countries effective April 1. All dues categories DO NOT include a published Membership Directory. Any surviving spouse of a lifetime member will no longer benefit from membership effective December 31. We will be glad to accept survivor spouse membership applications.
- 4. Effective with Gettysburg 2024 GN, all car judging will be on Friday. CLC and MRC board meetings will be scheduled on Saturday; all cars registered will be required to remain on display through Saturday at 4:00 pm unless removal is approved by National Chief Judge. These enhancements will allow tabulators sufficient time to accurately complete judging results and the awards committee time to assemble appropriate awards.
- A "rain policy" was approved by the BOD to be enacted at the Albuquerque GN. In the event that rain or inclement weather exists, and judging is halted or canceled, there will be no further judging and NO awards issued for any cars previously judged. More details to follow.
- Our webmaster, Stefan, asks everyone to access their member profile ASAP and edit all information to facilitate accurate personal/vehicle information for transfer into the new system.


