

AL VIZZONE'S CADILLAC COLLECTION

Here are some photos of my Cadillacs to share with club members. The blue one is a 1999 Cadillac DeVille with 215,300 miles; the gold one is a 2002 Cadillac Deville with 203,400 miles; the black one is a 2004 Cadillac DTS with 137,500 miles; the white one is a 2004 Cadillac DeVille with 87,900 miles; and finally, my silver one is a 2004 Cadillac DeVille with 179,900 miles on the body. I had the entire drivetrain rebuilt on that one because in 2019 the car was in Florida, where my parents were snow birds.

My sister was down there and wanted to drive them home, and the car kept displaying a "check the coolant" message. I told her to take it to Cadillac to get checked, but she refused. It had a bad reservoir and the water pump was starting to fail. They drove 1,500 miles and overheated five times. The car made it home but by 2020 the heads were starting to fail.

I took it to my friend to make sure I was correct about the heads and he agreed. I was going to get it repaired but my friend said that with 176,500 miles, it was not worth it. Too much wear and tear on the engine at that point. I agreed and had a new engine built to the new specs of the Northstar. Later we decided that the transmission had so many miles so why not get a new one, and I found one at Gear Head.

Finally, everything was put back together, and the end of May of this year the car hit the road. It was a lot of fun and a lot of work. I do love my Northstar engines, as they are light and powerful. I have always said if you take care of them, they will take care of you, as you can see from the high mileage all my engines have taken me.
