Now you are probably wondering the same thing I am. What about the collector cars? They are going to be over 15 years old. Can they be repaired? I am not certain. That is likely to be the last issue considered. Car collectors are in the minority compared to everyone who drives a car. I'll be surprised if something like this would actually pass into official legislation. It would be too much of a cost burden for many people. Manufacturers however would love something like this. Parts suppliers would like it too. Suppliers don't like having to maintain small volumes of parts simply for repair purposes. Again, I have no ability to confirm that this is true. Only time and good reporting will tell.

As I finish this message, I can tell everyone to enjoy the springlike weather. By the time this gets into your hands, it'll probably feel like winter again. Whatever the weather is, if you don't like it, just give it a few hours. It is Chicago after all.

### **CLC Winter Board Meeting Notes**

### Notes from the CLC Winter Board Meeting By Glenn Brown

I attended the Club and CLC MRC Board meetings in January. The following are several issues which may be of interest to our Region members.

#### **MRC**

The '24 MRC Fall Festival is still being planned. The current plan is to conduct it in a manner similar to what was ultimately done in'23. The details of the event are still being worked out with an emphasis of getting the detail out earlier this year. The plan is to also bring back the Sunday Morning Gull Lake Yacht Club Brunch, though as a free standing activity.

The MRC is evaluating its holding with the thought of deaccessioning several vehicles this year. One of which is a recently donated 1939 Cadillac sedan street rod project.

MRC Donation: Reminder that you can support the MRC on a tax deductible monthly basis through your bank or for those members who are in a position to have RMD from their retirement account, that they can donate it directly to the MRC tax free.

Additionally, the Board voted to add the MRC's Operations manager to the MRC Executive Board.

#### Club

The Club is financially sound. While membership numbers are down, the changing of the Office contractor and internet hosting resulted in reduced costs saving enough money to offset, at least this year, the lost income. We will need to be a bit more aggressive in recruiting new and retaining members.

Additionally, ad revenue for The Self-Starter publications is way down. Many vendors are eschewing print ads and going digital only. Cadillac, while continuing to support the Club in other way, has decided not to do *Self-Starter* ads this year. Kevin Bielinski, the recently appointed Western Region Vice President passed away on January 24<sup>th</sup>. He was 61.

The Club has chartered a new Region in Palm Springs on a Provisional basis. The specific boundaries are to be worked out.

A NEW 1959-60 Chapter has been chartered on a Provisional basis. Chapter director is Frank Nicodemus.

The 1959-1960 Authenticity Manual is now available. The cost is \$99.

The Second Edition 1942-1947 Authenticity Manual is now available.

The Club has sponsored a successor to the Roy A. Schneider Cadillac books. This one covers the 1970 to 1979 period. It will be available for sale at the GN this summer. The author will be available there to autograph copies of the book. The cost will be \$99.95. (I have a flyer)

The Board voted to limit the ability to post on the Club internet Forum to members, primarily to limit the proliferation of spammers, but also to encourage all participants to be members. Remember, we have a \$25 membership level. Non-members will still be able to view posts. The plan is to implement this change on May 1, 2024. There will be an announcement of the change 60 days prior to the change.

Mecum Auctions has agreed to provide discounted auction access passes to those who renew their lapsed memberships this year; details to come. By the way they left Chicago, because that had outgrown the space.

'24 Driving Tour "Cads in Kansas" will be based in Wichita, Kansas, August 27<sup>th</sup> -September 1<sup>st</sup>. (I have the detailed flyers) '25 Driving Tour will be in Northern New York. The "Lakes Tour" October 15-18.

GN's: '24 Gettysburg: Registrations are going very well. As of January 27, 320 people and 67 cars were registered, '25 Nashville, '26 Charlotte. NMTC is taking suggestions for a '27 location west of the Mississippi river.

There will be a CLC Board election this year. There are 20 candidates for 20 positions, but we still need you to vote. We have a new voting methodology this year. Online voting will be available. Details will be in the March Self-Starter, and will close on April 19

There was a robust discussion relative to CLC Judging. The Board directed that:

The modified car class trophies be upgraded; and the judging of Primary Class cars be done use the previous judging form (currently used only for Touring class). The newer more complex form would continue to be used for the "Senior" cars; and, the previous award progression from Primary 1<sup>st</sup> place to Wreath and Crown awards be restored, that is that gaining a Wreath or Crown award would require that the car be judged at Senior level to earn those awards.

The matter has been referred to the Judging Committee for implementation.

Lots of folks stopped by our booth at the BOPC Swap Meet. A few people gave us a list of items they have for sale. Some of these items are priced beyond reason, but you never know, if you need the item, make an offer. The worst they can do is say no.

If it hasn't been driven occasionally and maintained, it is going to need a lot of work; so DRIVE YOUR CAR! Second, know what your car is worth before you post it for sale. There is a pot for every lid, but unless they find Oprah's garter belt in the glove box, that car is going to be for sale for a LONG time.


