FANTASTIC COLLECTION OF 1959 CADILLACS

I've always liked Cadillacs, even at a young age. In 1977, when I was eighteen, I saw a 1937 Cadillac Fleetwood advertised in the local paper. My Father and I purchased the car for \$3,750. We had the car restored and it is still in my collection. That car is obviously my favorite, but I always had a liking for the '59 Cadillac. I purchased my first '59 in 2001, a red and white Eldorado Seville. Since then my collection of '59's has grown to seventeen.

My collection doubled last year with the purchase of an S&S hightop ambulance, and seven low-mileage '59's. None of the eight cars ran! I purchased the ambulance in March and started a complete restoration right away, which should be completed by June. The other seven cars were from a collector in Florida, and they had not been started since the 1980's. The lowest mileage is a Woodrose coupe with 12K miles. The car was still on original tires; exhaust, belts, hoses, and the spare tire were never used. A white Sedan deVille with 15K miles, and most of the others are under 34K miles. The cars are now all running.



THE AMELIA ISLAND CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE

1931 CADILLAC 452A ALL-WEATHER PHAETON
MCKEEL AND SOON HAGERTY TRAVERSE CITY, MI

The Cadillac 452-A was announced six weeks after the stock market crash of October 29, 1929. Off to a good start with 1221 cars sold in April and May 1930, sales soon plummeted as the Depression took hold. General Motors subsequently built these cars to order with as few as 50 vehicles produced in 1935 and 1937.

The Model 452-A is powered by a 452 cid overhead-valve V-16 engine which was incredibly smooth and produced 160 horsepower. It was claimed to be the fastest accelerating car of its time mostly due to the 300 lb./ft of torque.

On January 4, 1930 at the New York Auto Show, a crowd of 70,000 people jostled for a glimpse of the new American "Supercar," the 16-cylinder Cadillac. Until that moment only Bugatti had produced a V-16-cylinder engine and that was two eight-cylinder engines bolted together.

The Cadillac engine was the first 16-cylinder engine designed from scratch. The brainchild of Owen Nacker, it used a 45-degree bank angle and overhead valves which allowed a narrow width. It was also styled with hidden wiring, polished aluminum and valve covers with brushed aluminum-ridged surfaces.

The convertible coupe, Style 4235, priced at \$6,000, was the most expensive of the open two-door cars. This car was built in the first week of June 1930 by Vernetwood in the Detroit factory making it truly a coachbuilt car. The windshield has a 2 1/2 degree rake, adding the sleek profile and it has roll up windows and a flush fitting top. It is finished in the original colors and is one of only ten remaining.

Affectionately known as "Thunder Guts," this Bentley started life as a four-door saloon originally bodied by Freestone and Webb. After an accident in 1936 it was sent back to Bentley Motors for a rebuild. In 1939 four Cambridge University students in England drove this car to Andorra and back to England. Rock and Roll Hall of Famer Brian Johnson purchased the vehicle in 2009. An avid car enthusiast and driver, Johnson is best known as the former lead singer of AC/DC and star of the television series "Cars That Rock with Brian Johnson."

1959 CHEVROLET STINGRAY RACER
GENERAL MOTORS HERITAGE CENTER STERLING HEIGHTS, MI

In 1958, newly-appointed GM design chief Bill Mitchell wanted to build a Corvette racecar capable of beating Europe's best. With the availability of Zora Arkus-Duntov's defunct 1957 SS test mule chassis, Mitchell's XP-87 was underway. Mitchell's project had to be privately financed. GM insisted that Mitchell's design have no recognizable association with the Chevy brand or Corvette name so the XP-87 name was dropped and changed to Stingray. Completed in 1959, Mitchell's Stingray was fitted with a high-compression, fuel injected 283 c.i. V-8 engine producing 315 hp and entered into SCCA C-Class competition. At the end of the 1960 season, Mitchell retired the Stingray from competition, converted it for street use and exhibited it as an experimental show car. The stunning concept was driven by none other than the "King of Rock and Roll" Elvis Presley in the 1967 film "Clash of the Titans." The son of an oil tycoon, Elvis drives the heavily-modified Stingray from Texas to Florida where he trades identities with a water ski instructor and hijinks and romance ensue.


