



Registration: You must register your car by the end of the meeting on Tuesday, May 26 for the \$25 registration fee. You may also do it online and bring the form and fee. Please register so we know how many and cards can be made for the show. Day of the show registration is dependent on space available and \$30.

Show Check-in. You will need to check in for the show to receive your number and swag. It will be in the lot across from Guitar Center off of Sunset Road (north side) from 8:30 to 10:30 a.m. After 10:30, please go to the club booth in front of Coffee Bean & Tea, across from the green. If you prepaid, you still need to check in and get your swag and number.


Show Field. If you have been to CTTY before, the planned layout is the same except there is no parking on the green. Las Vegas Cadillac Club/ Guests Parking: "Main" street across from the

Parking. Please DO NOT park without direction from parking staff. They will let you know when to move onto the show field from the check-in area. Once parked, unless an emergency, plan to stay all day (It's a safety issue). All cars will exit the southside.

 **Awards.** Did I get picked for an award? Watch for a bright red star on your Cadillac. It should be on your Cadillac no later than 2 p.m. Awards are at the booth at 3 p.m.

President's Road Trip Continues



Resuming last month's road trip story, After leaving YUMA we traveled toward Chandler Az. On the way we stopped by what we said was on "Radiator Springs" road or the **Dwarf Car Museum**.

History of the Dwarf Car Museum. Ernie Adams had a fascination with cars starting back in grade school. He would admire the cars of the time, drew them for

school assignments and even built a wooden car as long as a crate box with steering and peanut butter jar lids for taillights. His mother would pull him throughout his hometown of Harvard, Nebraska.

The first Dwarf Car came to life in 1965 as a 28 Chevy two-door sedan made out of nine old refrigerators. Ernie began gathering the materials for this little car in 1962. By 1965 he had enough materials and an 18 hp Wisconsin motor to begin construction. With a homemade hacksaw made from a chair frame, hammer and a chisel, Ernie began construction. He had no idea what this would be the beginning of. Because this is the first Dwarf Car ever built, it is known as "GRANDPA DWARF." This first Dwarf Car is kept in running order and is still driven today.



After leaving the Dwarf Race Cars, Ernie had learned a lot about bending and shaping metal. He loved to see heads turn in admiration of the Dwarf Race Cars while being towed down the highway. Ernie knew it was time to change and put his metal shaping skills to the test. Now he wanted a fully dressed Dwarf Car with fenders, chrome, finished interior and most of all street legal and the Dwarf Car Cruiser was born.

This was a fun stop for mor information go to DwarfCarPromotions.com.

During our stay in Chandler, we visited the Arizona Railroad Museum. This was a wonderful little museum with both indoor and outdoor exhibits. Well worth the stop.

Our last major stop on this 1500-mile trip with trains, planes, boats and automobiles was in Phoenix at the new/relocated **Martin Auto Museum**. Talk about beautiful and Cadillacs everywhere. A few are below.

Created in 2005, the Martin Auto Museum is the brainchild of owner and founder Mel Martin. Mel saw a need to share a collection of vehicles that represent significant periods in automotive history. After 12 years of operation, Mel had more vehicles in storage than he did in the museum! It was time to move to a bigger building. In March of 2022, the new and improved Martin Auto Museum and Event Center opened.


