Green Chimneys Show—May 5th, 2018

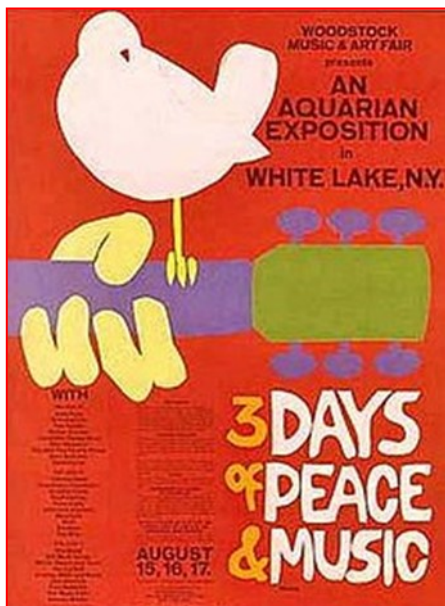
