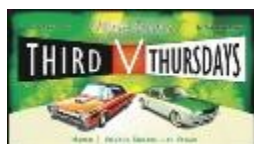

1927 — The LaSalle



In the News May 21, 1927

In 1927 GM INTRODUCES THE LA SALLE, an elegant, upmarket, yet more affordable, automotive brand for the Cadillac division. The La Salle was offered in a full range of body styles, including Fisher and Fleetwood custom designs. Cadillac loaned the new marque its "Ninety Degree V-8," which, in the smaller La Salle, created a sporty, fast and agile driving experience. Designed by Harley Earl, the stylish cars set a new trend in American automotive styling, leading to Earl's appointment as the head of General Motors' design studios.

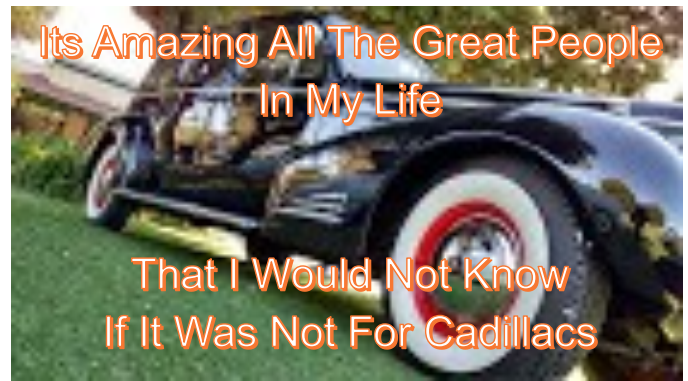
