





So Just How Do You Rewire a 1941 Cadillac

All Cadillac - LaSalle, 1936 and on, employ a front and rear set of wiring harnesses. The "Front Set" (dash, engine, head lights, and accessories) is determined by the specific year and series. Also, the "Rear Set" (body, interior lights, tank unit, and tail lights) is determined by the specific year, series and body style. Body styles are convertible (all open

cars), or closed body which refers to all other styles. Turn signals and fog (trippe) lights are options that can be added to all models (we include turn signals as standard equipment from 1938 on). No system includes spark plug wires nor battery cables.

NOTE TO JERRY: SAVE YOUR OLD WIRING UNTIL THE NEW SYSTEM IS INSTALLED AND TESTED. EVERY YEAR HAS UNIQUE LIGHT SOCKETS AND / OR FITTINGS WHICH MUST BE REUSED.




