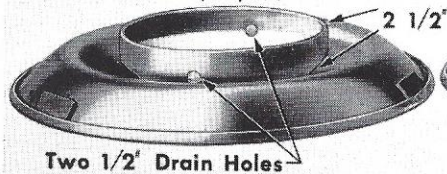


TWO DRAIN HOLES DISTINGUISH 1948 SERIES WHEEL DISC FROM 1947 SERIES WHEEL DISC

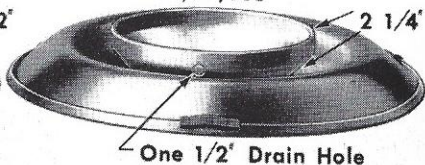

The illustration above will assist Servicemen in identifying the difference in Wheel Discs for 1947 and 1948 Series 61, 62, and 60S Cadillac Cars.

The 1948 Series Wheel Disc, Part No. 350 8244, has two $\frac{1}{2}$ " drain holes on the inside retainer while the 1947 Series Wheel Disc, Part No. 350 7820, has one

$\frac{1}{2}$ " drain hole through its inside retainer.

The 1947 and 1948 Series Wheel Discs *are not interchangeable* because the inside retainer on the 1948 Series Wheel Disc is $\frac{1}{4}$ " deeper than the 1947 Series Wheel Disc retainer to fit the increased wheel rim width which is used with the 8:20x15 low pressure tires on 1948 cars.
