The 1946 models were carry-over models from the pre-war 1942s. The 1947s were introduced that January and were only mildly freshened versions of the 1946s, costing about \$200 more than the previous year's models. Additional brightwork, trim changes, and updates to the grille made the 1947 models distinguishable from the previous year. In the front, the 'egg-crate' grille had one fewer horizontal bars, and the parking lights became small, round units unless optional fog lamps were ordered. The 1946 rear fender shields were rubber, while the 1947 models were made of stainless steel. Another noticeable feature included the large, optional 'sombbrero' wheel covers. These quickly became popular with hot rodders and Cadillac owners.





According to the article, this particular Caddie was the last auto ever bought by Greenberg, a Hall of Fame slugger who spent his glory years with the Detroit Tigers. Greenberg, who was twice named the American League MVP and was the first of only four players in baseball history to win the award at two different positions. His son, Steve Greenberg, a former deputy commissioner of Major League Baseball and the founder of the television network that would become ESPN Classic, confirmed to Defector that the 1983 Caddie was indeed Dad's automobile. The younger Greenberg also says that the handwriting on the letter of authenticity "definitely" belongs to Tarola, his late step-mother. And, he says, no rollback of the odometer was required to come up with the incredibly low mileage count (26,000) on the nearly 40-year-old car. "My dad drove from his house in Beverly Hills to the Beverly Hills Tennis Club seven days a week, a trip of 2.2 miles each way," says Steve Greenberg. "And that was about it!"

How Does the Gas Pump 'Know' When Your Car's Tank Is Full?

To understand how a gas pump knows when the car's tank is filled up, then you're going to have to get your science "thinking cap" on. It's easy to think that the pump shutting off is just a result of a small switch or sensor on the pump, but that's only partially right. According to Optima Environmental Sciences, the gas pump shuts off due to the "Venturi Effect," which is when there is a reduction in fluid pressure when a fluid flows through a constricted section of a pipe. It's kind of like when you put your thumb over a garden hose that's spewing out water. Blocking the hose increases the pressure inside of it, which in turn speeds up the velocity of the water coming out of the end of the hose. But what does this have to do with filling up your car's gas tank?



Now that we're familiar with the Venturi Effect, we can take a closer look at what happens when you're waiting for the pump to fill up the car while you watch TV on the pump's monitor. While you're waiting, and the gas tank is filling up with gasoline, there is a small tube within the gas pump that's pumping the air out of the tank. According to Reader's Digest, when a tank is filled with gasoline, it's replacing the air that's in there with the liquid that's going in. The more gas that's in the tank, the more air needs to come out. That's where that small tube inside the gas pump comes into play.

At the end of that small tube inside the pump is a diaphragm that fills with air. When the fuel tank gets closed to being filled, that little tube sucks up the gas. And when the pump sucks up the gas, it evens out the pressure and creates a small suctioning force (the Venturi Effect), which in turn triggers the pump to shut off.

Remember not to "top off" when filling up your car's tank. Now that you're familiar with what happens when you fill up your car's gas tank, you can probably understand why it's not a good idea to "top off," or pump more gas when it's full. According to Clark.com, once a gas tank is full, there is no way to add more gas. In fact, if you pull the pump handle when the tank is already filled up, the pump will pull that extra gas back into the station's tank. That means you're technically wasting money by thinking that you're pumping more gas into the tank when in actuality, that's not the case.







New Home For the Cadillac

45 years ago on April 21, 1976, Cadillac Motor Car Division issued a press release announcing the "last American convertible had been built." To commemorate the anniversary of the final 1976 Bicentennial Eldorado Convertible being built, a special webpage that includes material and historical photos from three now-defunct websites, including an owner's registry that had been dormant for years:

clcpotomac-region.org/1976BicentennialEldoradoRegistry.htm

The 1976 Eldorado was still using the same basic bodyshell as the 1971. It was freshened with the 1975 model year. It gained rectangular headlamps and a new front bumper and grille. The rear had already been freshened with the 1974 model year gaining a new tail lamp arrangement and stronger impact bumper. Both front and rear bumpers telescoped into tapered end caps upon impact. This was the final look for the classic Eldorado styling. Rear fender skirts disappeared with the 1975 refresh. The exterior dimensions remained the same as the 1975 model year and the average size since the 1971 model year at 224.1" in length, 79.8" in width and a long 126.3" wheelbase.
