Ethanol fuel is a renewable energy source for the world but a constant source of problems for classic cars.

A recent outing in my 1975 Sedan deVille brought the new experience of hesitation and stalling on acceleration. The culprit turned out to be the Rochester Quadrajets Carburetor. Age and 10% ethanol fuel blends had either dried out or outright consumed the non-metallic parts of the carburetor, so it was time for a rebuild. A new carburetor could be had for \$400 plus core, but what fun is that? Do you recall a newsletter article from a couple of years ago when we replaced the air conditioning system in Fred Butalla's 1986 Fleetwood Brougham? I did. So I called Fred and cashed in a payback.



Fred didn't write the book on carburetors, but he OWNS the book; a 7 inch tall binder of specifications, technical instructions, service bulletins and parts lists from the 1930s to the late 1980s. If GM used it, it is in this book, and boy did it come in handy.

We started by removing the carburetor from the car, a task made more challenging by corroded fuel and brake booster lines. Once those lines were destroyed, the carb came right out. Of course replacing those lines still had to be done, and we went directly to [In Line Tube](#) ironically located near Rochester, Michigan. In Line Tube quickly shipped the lines we needed (**Pro Tip #1: For the extra \$5, buy the stainless steel tubes**) (**Pro Tip #2: To replace the fuel line, you need to remove the A/C Compressor drive belt**) (**Pro Tip #3: Know which bolts to loosen on the power steering pump to remove the belt or you will get a face full of power steering fluid – a friend told us that – okay, it was me after getting a face full of power steering fluid**).



Next up was finding the rebuild kit. There are a million places to buy a rebuild kit, but only one place to go if you want the right kit the first time and great advice if you get caught in an impossible spot (a friend told us that – okay, it was us after being caught in an impossible spot). [Cliff's High Performance Quadrajets](#) in Mount Vernon, Ohio. Cliff makes the kits specifically for your carburetor number and has pro tips to help you over the rough spots. No internet company does that, but Cliff's does.



With parts in hand, we started with a complete disassembly and a thorough cleaning of our carburetor.

In car circles, some people call the Quadrajets "quadra-junk", but once you see what makes the carburetor tick, you'll change your mind. The carburetor is the perfect mate to the

Cadillac engine. In two barrel mode it provides smooth steady fuel and air flow that makes the Cadillac cruise down the highway. When the secondary barrels kick in, it pours fuel into the engine by the barrel and has enough air-draw to suck pigeons in off the sidewalk. Bone stock from the factory it is perfectly balanced to provide smooth acceleration and quick responsive performance off the line or during passing.

Fred explained that it is possible to get even more performance by making a few simple modifications, such as boring out the tubes and adjusting the opening rate on the secondary barrels to allow for more performance. Of course as with anything in life, there are trade-offs. More performance means less fuel economy and better fuel economy means less performance. In my experience of driving this car over the last 15 years, the performance to economy ratio was just fine, so we opted to leave the carburetor's factory settings in place.



*As a side note I did ask Cliff, from Cliff's High Performance, if there was anything I could do to improve the performance of my 1987 Brougham with the 5.0 liter Quadrajets system. Cliff told me what I already knew; that the engine was designed for maximum fuel economy and minimal emissions, therefore performance was never going to be available for that car. I pressed and said that certainly SOMETHING could be done. Cliff relented and explained in very technical terms that I should, and I'm paraphrasing here: Take the engine out of the car, load it onto a C-135 Cargo Transport Plane, get to an altitude of 40,000 feet and push the engine out of the plane. At that point, the engine will travel as fast as it will ever go and use the least amount of fuel, but it would still pollute the air. So that is a "hard no" on improving the 87 Brougham. Cliff also happens to be hilarious.*

Once the carburetor's parts were completely cleaned, it was ready to be reassembled. Fred started by testing all the castings to make sure there would be no vacuum leaks, one leak was found and repaired. Next, we tested the needle seats for proper seal, they were found to leak a bit, so Fred used a steel bearing and punch to resurface the ports and they held like brand new. There is no point in putting new parts in a bad mount, so in this case, the preparation work was well worth the effort. A small amount of play was found in the primary and secondary butterflies, so they were bored out and new bushings were added.

During final assembly, it was necessary to properly adjust the float level and that required searching Fred's five billion page book of carburetors. After a bit of searching, the specs were found and the adjustments were made.

From that point, it became a whirl of fingers, parts and tools. I remember Fred being impressed by my ability to be blindfolded and placed in front of his broken A/C system, then 2 hours later (including barbeque lunch) having cold air come from the vents. I felt the same way watching Fred take that 500 piece Quadrajets jigsaw puzzle and come up with something that not only fit on the engine of my car, but started and ran!



I guess we all have our talents. I hope I never have to rebuild a Quadrajets on my own, but after seeing what an engineering marvel they are (and knowing Cliff is only a phone call away) I may give it a try. Now you might too.




