GM Authority: Average Cadillac Blackwing Buyer Is 10 Years Younger Than Non-BW Buyer
Of course, it should come as no surprise that the new Cadillac Blackwing sedans are attracting a younger crowd considering the impressive performance on offer. Under the hood, the 2022 Cadillac CT5-V Blackwing is motivated by the supercharged 6.2L V8 LT4, rated at 668 horsepower and 659 pound-feet of torque, while the 2022 Cadillac CT4-V Blackwing is motivated by the twin-turbocharged 3.6L V6 LF4, rated at 472 horsepower and 445 pound-feet of torque. As Leno confirms, **these vehicles are far from your grandpa's Cadillac.**

Cadillac—Fact or Fiction? Al Capone and FDR

Hours after Pearl Harbor was bombed on December 7, 1941, the Secret Service found themselves in a bind. President Franklin D. Roosevelt was to give his Day of Infamy speech to Congress on Tuesday, and although the trip from the White House to Capitol Hill was short, agents weren't sure how to transport him safely.

At the time, Federal Law prohibited buying any cars that cost more than \$750, so they would have to get clearance from Congress to

do that, and nobody had time for that. One of the Secret Service members, however, discovered that the US Treasury had seized the bulletproof car that mobster Al Capone owned when he was sent to jail in 1931. They cleaned it, made sure it was running perfectly and had it ready for the President the next day. Mechanics are said to have cleaned and checked each feature of the Caddy well into the night of December 7th, to make sure that it would run properly the next day for the Commander in Chief. And run properly it did. It had been painted black and green to look identical to Chicago's police cars at the time. To top it off, the gangster's 1928 Cadillac Town Sedan had 3,000 pounds of armor and inch-thick bulletproof windows. It also had a specially installed siren and flashing lights hidden behind the grille, along with a police scanner radio.

The major problems with the story are the following;

1) As erroneously reported by many authors and news outlets, the alleged Capone Cadillac in the story doesn't match the Presidential Cadillac car taken in a photo on December 8, 1941, enroute to Congress. For that matter, none of Capone's known two 1931 Cadillacs match the Presidential Cadillac leaving the White House December 8, 1941 or any photos shown of FDR motorcade after that date.

2) So even if anyone is trying to say that the late model shown in the first picture was Al's car then one would have to explain the following; In 1939, Capone had just left prison and had the mind of a 13 year old, so the angle that the Cadillac was probably a later model than

that of 1928 is unfounded. Al Capone was in prison from 1932 to 1939, was financially strapped and was in no position to purchase any armored Cadillacs while incarcerated. To this very day supposed Capone's owned guns and cars have become the stuff of legends!!

The portion of Highway 50 in Nevada runs for 287 miles. The Nevada Commission on Tourism created a "Highway 50 Survival Guide" that you can have stamped along your journey. If you get at least 5 of the 8 towns to stamp it, you can get a "Highway 50 Survivor" certificate.

Stops along the way are:

1. Carson City—The Capital. While Carson is a "modern" city, history buffs will enjoy exploring the buildings from the early days of the state. Some favorite places to visit are the Nevada State Railroad Museum, the V&T Railroad, and the state capitol building.
2. Dayton- Dayton has a population of around 9,000 people. It's listed as a Nevada Historical Marker by the Nevada State Historic Preservation Office.
3. Fernley-Fernley is situated at the junction of Highway 50 and Interstate 80. This is an important stop on our road trip. (Stock up on supplies and gas before you keep going east!)
4. Fallon—Main produce is alfalfa and "Heart O' Gold" cantaloupes. There is also the Naval Air Station Fallon. This base is where the TOPGUN training program resides; 110 miles to next stop!
5. Austin—The road between Fallon and Austin was the original pony express route. Be glad you are not riding this on horseback. Historical and has oldest general store in Nevada. Eureka—Historic Town of about 600
6. Ely—Ely began as a route along the Pony Express and grew in the early 1900's due to copper mining. The town's attractions include the Nevada Northern Railway.
7. Baker—We've made it! The little town of Baker (population around 70!) is our last stop on the journey. While Baker is quite small, it's the "home base" for visitors heading to the Great Basin National Park.

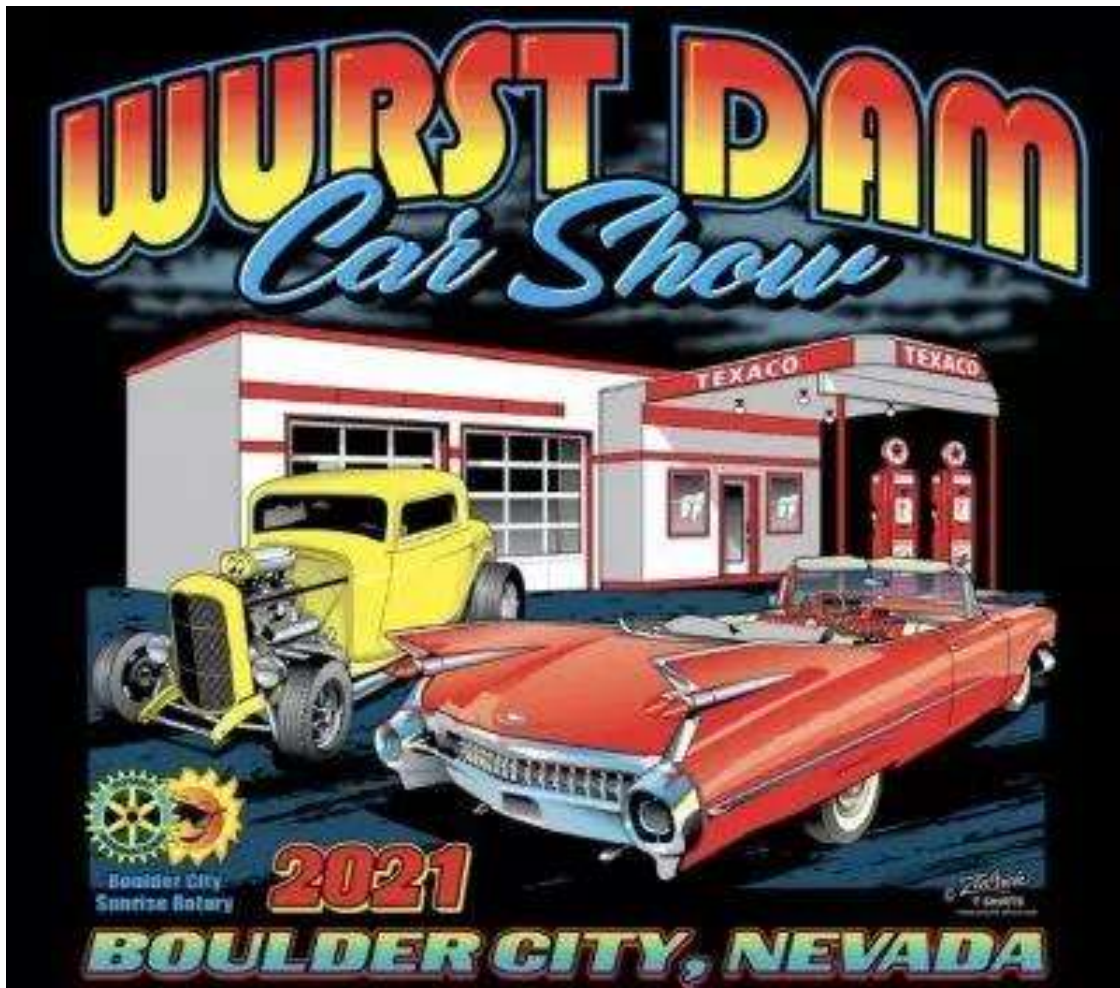
