This beautiful 1964 Cadillac Coupe deVille is owned and cared for by Charles Gambulos II and is one of 38,195 Cadillac coupes built for that year. Sitting on a 129.5" wheelbase and powered by a 429 cubic engine, this 4,500 pound luxury vehicle does0-60 in 8.3 seconds. The engine is a bored-out and superior upgrade to the '63 390 cubic inch engine with now having 340 horsepower at 4,600 rpm and 480 foot pounds of torque at 3,000 rpm. Interesting is that the Turbo-Hydromatic tranny for this year was actually a Buick-designed product until Cadillac built their own version for 1965.

SO YOU WANT TO SELL YOUR CAR ... WHAT'S IT WORTH?

- Get a Kelly Blue book quote. Loan value is close to wholesale.
- Get a Car Fax on your vehicle. Remember most appraisers will!
- Where's the title and vehicle pedigree?
- Is there a pay off?
- Call lien holder for the amount and date.
- When sold and you have money, you sign on the back of the title "seller" as your name appears on the front. Caution: now an open title!
- Be careful of scammers or out of town buyers.
- Never bring buyers to your home.
- Meet in daylight neutral safe location.
- Contact local police for advice including bad money especially if banks closed or Sunday cash sale.

Your number one purchase in life is cars. Cars can depreciate to extinction faster than you can pay for them. Most well cared for homes up appreciate. You can anaesthetize your cars condition and properly get it "lot ready" for sales perhaps for big bucks. Remember, vehicle excuses are costly leading to another "walk." No one wants to ride around in someone else's dirt. Pay attention for some uncomfortable truths!









Amateurish poorly prepared vehicles can't hide years of neglect, abuse and hogged up house keeping. To bring the Cadillac factory lacquer vehicle to near show room appearance, requires time, patience and a modest investment.

SO YOU WANT TO SELL YOUR CAR ... WHAT'S IT WORTH?

Three of my "driven daily" Cadillacs won top honors. My 1991 RWD Fleetwood, 91,000 miles and my 1970 Cadillac convertible took first place at NTX CLC. My 1983 Coupe Deville, 74,000 miles #333 won first place at California Grand National. I am now ready to share my "secretive" list of proven recommendations for having your Cadillac be at its best!

- Carefully remove all exterior Cadillac script and emblems including hood ornament. Use a plastic wedge as it deters scratching.
- Thoroughly hand wash exterior with non-harming "super clean" including bumpers, grill, and wheel well moldings. If your Cadillac has the beautiful wire rim wheel covers, clean each spoke by hand! Let dry.
- Repeat entire hand wash with full strength tar remover. Oil based tar and corrosive toxic road film create permanent body paint buffing swirls. WASH AGAIN and dry.
- Remove and discard soiled offensive under hood pads. Carefully reclean small round hood pad retainers for new pad installation after detailing. Dispose soiled pads properly!
- A dirty engine coated with contaminated spent oil and nasty toxic road particles harbors heat and can rob your vehicle of fuel and proper operating efficiency. Soiled filthy engine compartments disguise dangerous fuel, vacuum, gasket, hose leaks, cracked wiring, and failing belts.
- Before sending your vehicle to a professional detailing center for a complete interior exterior trunk and under the hood beauty treatment, remove ALL personal items from glove box, under the seats, CDs and trunk. Dog hair, French fries, spilled drinks, odors and most stains will be gone!
- After beauty treatment, a final touch. Perhaps a clay bar paint treatment or hand polish with Meguaire's paste cleaner wax in metallic red can.
- Now the glass like show stopper finish similar to an award winning custom paint invites touching and owning!
- From personally recommended "Original Parts Group" in California, order new authentic looking Cadillac script, emblems, under hood pad, cigarette lighters, ash trays, floor mats, trunk mat, carpet metal sill plates, air breather stickers, etc. All are high quality and cheap! No more buffing around brittle dirt polish caked emblems and script. Always an eye sore!
- Replace all four tires with correct white wall tires. New tires also hide worn components.
- Change oil and filter with Royal Purple synthetic oil. Classic Cadillacs deserve to have an oil that helps keep it at peak performance. Great for high mileage worn engines.






SO YOU WANT TO SELL YOUR CAR . . . WHAT'S IT WORTH?

- Change worn belts, hoses and clamps.
- Change battery. **Consider <u>under dash cut-off switch</u>**. My wife Connie considers this vital especially when your classic Cadillac is not driven every day. It is heaven to know it will start!
- Perform electrical systems check such as starter, alternator, etc.
- Replace all burned out bulbs and fuses.
- Replace windshield wiper blades. Top off windshield washer fluids.
- Repair needed? A small cut, tear, abrasion, even cigarette burn hole through the carpet or cloth, leather or vinyl seats and upholstery can most always be repaired and re-dyed perfectly to match by professional mobile restorer. These experts frequent new car dealers back lot trade ins awaiting their skilled touch. Politely inquire if you are in need of their services. They also fix badly discolored plastic head lamp covers to look like new.
- Install new lighters, ash trays, sill plates, mats, pads, and new high quality jumper cables, first aid kit, emergency lights, blankets, gloves, universal tools and fire extinguisher.
- A test drive is in order to check all systems and roadability.
- ◆ If you are interested in selling, take your gorgeous ride for what is called a "buy bid." Just say, Not here to buy today; are you interested in my car? How much for a "buy bid"? Go to Car Max, new car dealers, used car managers, wholesale and special interest dealers. Then do the math. On-line? Be careful! Quick on cash. Weak on amount. Check your agreed selling price. Has it been compromised?
- Advertise don't lie! Be realistic and honest. Feature your maintenance history file!
- Don't forget CLC members! Place ad in our monthly newsletter. Our buyer for Fleetwood Brougham was told by friend to purchase from a CLC member!
- ♦ It is only worth what someone will pay!
- Many of my owners saw their "trade in toad" now lot ready! They said, If I knew it would look that good, I would have kept it for a second car!
- Obviously, you are smart enough to know that all of the above is good for any vehicle you own!

I have heart felt sorrow for the loss of my long time Cadillac friend, John Foust. He was a true Cadillac man and one you could count on for helping find a part or giving you excellent advice. RIP John.


Allante and XLR Club 2023 Italian Grand Tour




