Our 31st CCNJ Fall Car Show took place on Sunday, November 13, 2022, at the State Line Lookout in Alpine, NJ. The day gradually cleared after a shaky morning of drizzle and heavy cloud cover, but the temperature struggled to crack the 50 degree mark even at the height of the afternoon. Members, friends, and other spectators were game, however, and bundled up to enjoy a show at which the cars were as cool as the weather.

The day may have been chilly but the reception was warm. Nearly 45 Cadillics turned out to line the Palisades in gleaming chrome. CCNJ members arrived in droves, as they typically do, and we had some stellar representation from nearby states, as land yachts from Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and New York cruised in by land and over the river to join us. 
