#### Marilyn Monroe's Famous '59


The year was 1959, a year of significant events:





#### The Year Was 1971...

#### The Vietnam War had 3 More Long Years to go

Two years after the Tet Offensive, Americans needed affirmation that we were still the world's great force to be reckoned with. Some of those strong societal convictions manifested themselves in the production of some of the most iconic automobiles ever produced in the history of automaking of that era.

Cadillac introduced a new look of leadership in 1971 with the completely restyled model year. Sculptured attributes included new luxurious conveniences, foremost engineering innovation and glamorous interiors. Choices of magnificent tufted brocade broadcloths adorned many new Cadillacs and once again, state-of-the-art features like elimination of the B pillar on all Sedans, DeVille Convertible and the Fleetwood Sixty Special was now replaced by the Brougham Series. Coupe DeVille enjoyed very renowned popularity and stainless steel body adornments appeared on all models.

A new Turbo-Hydramatic transmission was introduced with newly refined braking systems along with a new exterior louvered flow-through cabin ventilation system.

Cadillac Motor Division sold a record number of units with 69,345 Sedan DeVilles and 66,081 Coupe DeVilles shipped to Cadillac Dealers. Some assembly took place outside of Detroit at GMAD, General Motors Assembly Division in Linden, NJ. The sum total of all sales for the calendar year, including professional cars and commercial chassis models hit a new all time high of 267,868 units.



# Post Script: The Most Often Neglected Part of Your Car...Your Tires



#### When was the last time you checked your tires?

People forget that their entire ride and all it's accoutrements are riding on their tires. As the tread begins to wear down, it decreases the tire's ability to remove debris and causes the tire to lose grip with the road. On wet days, this could cause you to hydroplane and lose control. On icy and snowy days, this could cause your tires to slide and make your car go off the road. Also be aware of unusual tire wear patterns that can indicate suspension problems, misalignment issues and incorrect inflation.

# Consult your owners manual for the tire data information that is specific to your car model. Always observe the gross vehicle weight statistic and how that correlates to tire performance and specifically, inflation. With so many types of tires out there, it's easy to get confused about what

specifically, inflation. With so many types of tires out there, it's easy to get confused about what serves your car best and ultimately, the type of ride you desire based on your vehicle usage and driving habits.

For those who like a "cushy" ride, an all-season tire will give you the best ride, however, they also usually wear faster because the sidewalls are made of soft composite rubber. Ideally, you should determine the payload requirements based on your type of vehicle; whether it be a passenger sedan, crossover or SUV for your best tire selection criteria. Also be aware that tires are date-stamped on the sidewall, so remember that tires can get dry-rotted with age as well. All too many times, especially with classics, the owners forget when they enter the open road that their tires are five years old, or more for example and not road-safe, especially at high speeds. **SAFETY FIRST**, that's what it's all about.

#### Here's some Sound Advice:

- 1. Always check your tires before any road trips
- 2. Observe correct inflation for your specific car
- 3. Inspect tread depth routinely for normal wear
- 4. Replace tires that have damaged sidewalls, etc.
- 5. <u>Remember</u> seasonal changes in the outside ambient temperature can affect inflation
- **6.** Purchase a tire protection plan for road hazards
