The car cruising season got off to a stellar start on Sunday, April 16, 2023, with the advent of our 32nd annual Cadillac Club of North Jersey Spring Car Show. The festivities took place at the State Line Lookout in Alpine, NJ.

## **MAKING MAGIC AGAIN**


**J**oe Vanacore notes that this year's spring show was made extra special for him because he was again able to catch up with his friend, William Cujilve, who attended the show. William is the former owner of "Blue Magic," the 1973 Cadillac Eldorado currently owned by Joe and seen in the photos presented here. (Their story is profiled in last year's February issue of *Caddy Chatter*.)

Bonding over "Blue," Joe and William have become longtime buddies. At the show, William confessed an old story that explains the slight bit of damage in the grill's chrome (barely seen, circled in white, in the photo on the right below).

"Willy was driving on the Grand Concourse in the Bronx," Joe reports, "doing about 5-10 miles per hour, when he looked to his side and saw this beautiful lady walking on the sidewalk, looking at his vehicle. You know what happened next...he drove right into the car in front of him. Thank God for the bumper absorber impact shocks that had just come out in '73. The entire bumper retracted and made slight contact with the grill, then bounced right back into place."










