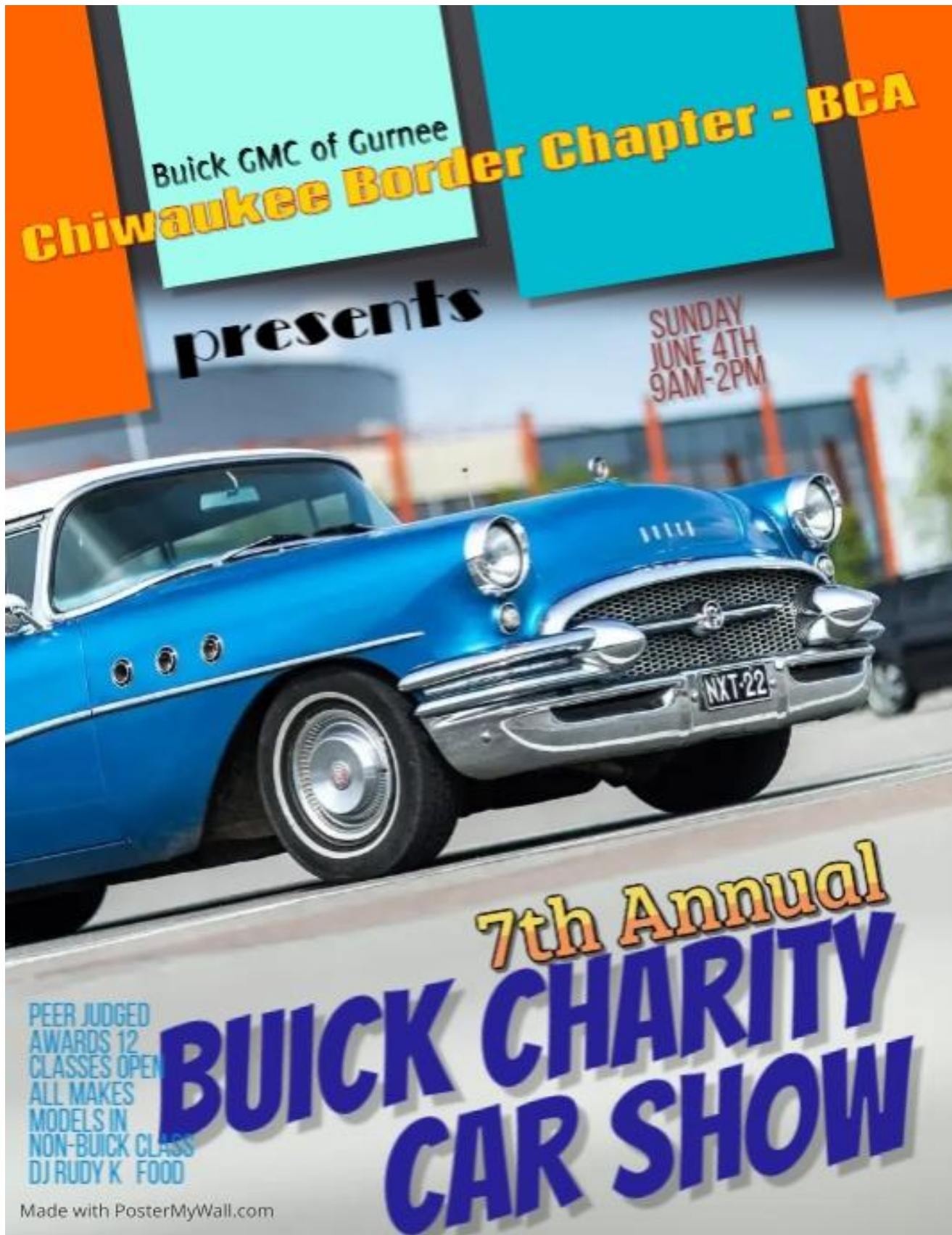

As soon as the car is back from the paint shop, we are going to finish the AC work and hopefully our usual hot air will be replaced with nice cold air. Membership has its benefits!

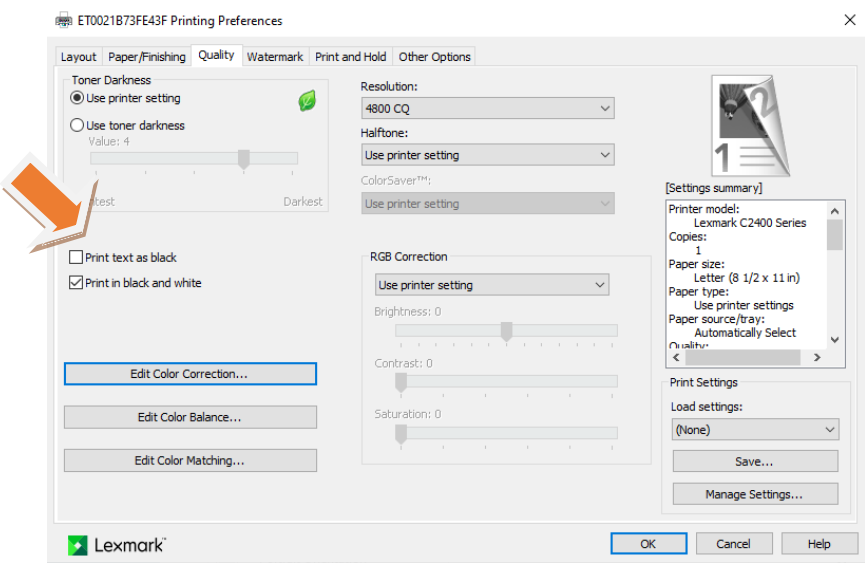

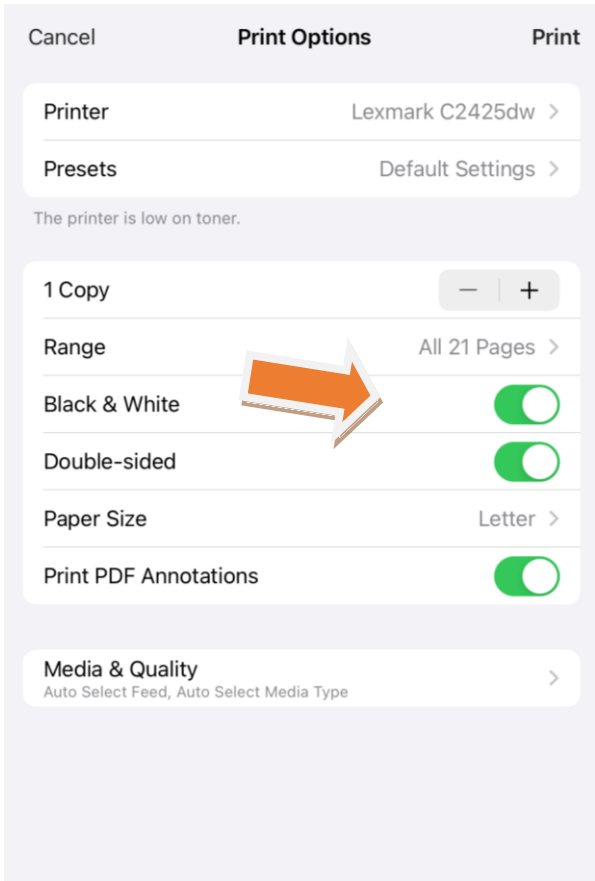
