New, this 1973 luxurious car's base cost was \$7,681 (today=\$54,267). It was over 231.5 inches long and weighed over 5,000 pounds. Power was 472 cu in. with 220 BHP @ 3800 RPM and 365 Ft-Lbs. torque @ 2400 RPM. This ride could do 0-60 in 10.9 seconds. 9,315 were built. This one was mine for over 100,000 miles. It had green leather interior and was smooth and quiet in town and on the road, And it never saw a gasoline service station it didn't like.



PATE SWAP MEET TILE REFERBISH PARTY

MARCH 23, 2024 (March 30, rain date.)

We will meet at 10:00 a.m. on March 23rd at the Center Conex in Zone Zero.

The Tile Refurbish Party's purpose is to inspect each vendor's space-marking tile and each tile tub. Each of the 44 tubs has a laminated map of the zone and the blocks assigned for that tub. We place the tiles in the correct tub, in numerical order by blocks (even numbers in one stack and odd numbers in second stack). Each stack gets a big rubber band to secure it. Missing tiles or unreadable tiles are replaced, using the vinyl film from the roll to make the replacement tile. There are about 11,000 tiles, but the work goes fast and we have fun with the get-together of club members. Refreshments will be provided, along with required supplies. However, please dress appropriately for the weather to be comfortable as we will be outside, and BRING A CHAIR. We need as many of you to come as possible, so mark the date and come on out.





Carriage tops, grills, spares, real gold script, Vogue Tyres, real wire wheels create a longer lower image. Ideally personal distinctive, flawless, sportiest of closed cars all sold at "no discount" at historic numbers in conservative Birmingham, Alabama.



Tile Party



In 1986, downsized Sevilles suffered the humiliation of falling more than 5,000 units short of the unloved Cadillac Cimarron. I resurrected our oldest inventory Seville. The featured 6 month old 1988 Seville received a maximum stunning restyling. Now a show quality showroom image. Admired by our young family dealer, Mr. Drennen said, *Alex, you've spent \$5,400 of after market on this aged Seville and it's going to sell?* I said, *Absolutely!* He said, *You better be right*. It sold that very day to a prominent business person for "all the money."



The gorgeous motor car pictured above is the 1956 Cadillac 62 Series Coupe (2 door hardtop). A brilliant climax of 54 years, "Standard of the World." I traded for it as Used Car Manager for Wagner Cadillac, Richmond, Indiana, in 1976. Similar almost ageless images of Cadillac come to mind. Pulse rates go up with judicious approval. Functionally styled dual bumper exhausts, deep fluted stainless steel wheel covers fit only 1956 Cadillacs and correct white wall tires. The reaction of our traditional Cadillac owners viewing their 1985 downsides Coupe DeVille was inexpressible shock!

The Tastefully restyled Coupe DeVille, Vogue Tyres and real chrome wire wheels portray a longer lower Cadillac look. Note: The real gold script similar to above 1956 Cadillac deck lid. Secret: The sculptured Vogue whitewall tire meets the chrome wheel for unique traditional look.


