1992 Ferrari Yellow Cadillac Allante

In 1995 I was at Rodger Meier Cadillac on LBJ and the tollway in Dallas, Tx., looking at a red one owner 1990.5 Cadillac Allante. Previous owner was Ed Hagar owner of Hagar Slacks. I did buy the Car, and owned it for a couple of years. A couple years later I started looking for another Allante. I was driving past Park Place Lexus in Plano, Tx. one day and saw a yellow 1992 Allante setting in there used car section. I stopped to look at it. It had around 50,000 miles on it. The used car salesman came out to speak with me, said they wanted \$15,000 for it. I thought that was too much so didn't buy it. I later on found out the original dealer that sold that car was Rodger Meir Cadillac. I was able to speak with the salesman, Fred Price, at Rodger Meir, who gave me the story on the yellow Allanté. He said he had a customer from Dallas come in and wanted a Ferrari yellow Allante, would buy that color only. Rodger Meier contacted GM, GM said they would paint three Alante's Ferrari yellow only, and Rodger Meier would have to take all three. Rodger Meier did just that and took all three. Talking with the salesman at Rodger Meier, one yellow Allanté was sold in Dallas, one sold in Austin, and the other one was sold in Oklahoma City. The one that was sold in Dallas, was sold to Park Place Lexus in Plano, was sold to a man in Florida who eventually moved it to Tulsa, OK and put in storage. He died, so the family offered it for sale. I talked to the family, saw that the price was ok, but I just didn't have room for it. Finally, a classic car dealer in New Jersey bought it. John Monzo bought from them. John has for sale for thirty K. The one that was sold in Austin, Tx. wound up in California near San Diego. The one that went to Oklahoma City, as far as I know is still in OK City. I could have bought same car twice.



LUXURY COMPACT CADILLAC OWNERS ENDORSE CIMARRON



The brutal winter months of 1980, a horribly depressed economy and very competitive "Detroit—metro" market, yet at Don Massey Cadillac, Plymouth, Michigan, we excelled as the nation's largest! Detroit dealers were closed Saturday and Sunday. My weekends were with my wife and children in Grand Rapids, Ohio, about an hour drive. Late evening, I was rushed to St. Luke's hospital for emergency surgery to remove a diseased gall bladder. In 1981, they cut through your stomach muscles so 18 stitches. You must also exhale in a plastic tube floating plastic balls—painful. Folks, you can't drive a car for three months!



DETROIT'S TIMELESS GLOBAL "ENDURING" CADILLAC





I had just closed on a new modest three acre country home from fellow Rotarian realtor John D. Kurfess PDG. No job and no income for three months! Dick Gumpp, owner of Gumpp Cadillac, Toledo, Ohio, called and said, I'm sending you a new Cadillac Cimarron demonstrator. I know you can't drive. As my special agent, manage your own deals, appraise your own trades, arrange spot deliveries from your home. We will expedite paperwork. What do you require? I said, Two of your oldest late model Cadillacs with four new Cadillac tires, new batteries, re-detailed, full tanks of gas, and two new slow moving Cadillacs. I passenger demoded my Cimarron creating owners, averaging ten new and pre-loved sold Cadillacs a month. We provided food, spirits, smokes and fun. They all got three days to change their minds. Why? Anything sold in the home has "right to rescind". No one did.

By January 1982, Lone Star Cadillac, Dallas, Texas, was in top ten in the nation. Burt Wyland G.S.M. hired me over the phone. Note the impressive black 1982 Lone Star Cimarron with restyled grill, wire wheels and Vogue high speed tyres replacing Cimarron only weakness; tires



Cimarron - first four-cylinder Cadillac since 1914 and first manual shift since 1953. Even the trunk was carpeted and nine handbuffed body colors was standard with every luxury feature: air conditioning, stainless steel exhaust, reclining body-contoured leather bucket seats, and AM-FM stereo. "See, touch and experience Cimarron. A bargain in true luxury for about \$12,000."

The 1983 Cimarron was vastly improved. The finest example of Cimarron was 1988. -Cimarron's last year. Its new V-6 120 HP automatic had faster 0-60 times than a 442 Oldsmobile. If you can find a 1983-1988 Cimmaron, study it and road test it! What a bargain in luxury. Fun to drive quickly with tunes playing on radio!

Cadillac Assistant General Sales Manager, Carver Hendrix, endorsed me as Sales Manager for Drennen Cadillac. Young owner Ralph Drennen was in need of help. I made the sales money flow out the windows. Ralph promptly sold out to the Buick dealer with Cadillac demanding new facilities.

In my High school days 1959, Rossford, Ohio, I heard, "You don't need factory air cars.

Its only hot three months of the year." My first new car 1964 Grand Prix had factory air. As a Pontiac Cadillac GMC dealer in 1972, Cadillac got my irrevocable letter that all inventory and sold Cadillacs must have factory air, tilt and telescope steering wheel, electric rear window defogger and dual remote outside mirrors. No non-air dealer trades. In 2024 its hard to find a new car or truck without factory air!


