# **Up and Coming Events**



Largest Steam Locomotive in The World Big Boy No. 4014 was delivered to Union Pacific in December 1941. The locomotive was retired in December 1961, having traveled 1,031,205 miles in its 20 years in service. Union Pacific reacquired No. 4014 from the Rail-Giants Museum in Pomona, California, in 2013, and relocated it back to Cheyenne to begin a multi-year restoration process. It returned to service in May 2019 to celebrate the 150th Anniversary of the Transcontinental Railroad's Completion. NTXCLC will have a road tour to visit this display on Oct 11th.

"Frontiers of Flight Museum" at Love Field Many of our members have been to this fine museum, but new members and others will enjoy the visit. NTX will do this on November 9th with a rain date of November 16th.

National Vietnam War Museum, Weatherford, Texas This museum is right near where I spent time during the beginning of my adventures as an Army Aviator, Ft. Wolters. The museum has been designed to tell the unbiased story of the approximately 2.7 million servicemen and women who served there; the civilian contractors who supported their efforts; the Vietnamese people, their culture and history; and those on the home front, both those who supported and those who protested the war. NTX will do a road caravan on December 14th to visit this museum.

#### **DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

**VICE PRESIDENT**: The Vice President shall perform such duties as may be assigned to him/her by the President or the Board. In case of death or absence of the President, He/she shall perform the duties of President.

**SECRETARY:** The Secretary shall record and keep all minutes of the Board and the annual meetings of the members and mail them to all board members within two weeks after the meetings. The Secretary shall carry on and maintain a file of Club correspondence and shall perform such other duties as the President or the Board may direct.

**MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN:** The Membership Chairman shall actively promote membership in the Club. 



## **Cadillac: Interesting Facts**

Cadillac, a car brand founded in 1902 and named after the French explorer who founded Detroit, is among the world's most prestigious automobile brands. As part of General Motors, Cadillac is known for luxury and innovation.

- 1. Early Recognition: Cadillac got the nickname "Standard of the World" in 1908 when it won the Dewar Trophy for its cars' reliable and interchangeable parts.
