Did you know that the Patrick Auto Group is named after Patrick Dawson, the son of Hanley Dawson III. If the name Hanley Dawson sounds familiar to Cadillac fans, that's because Hanley Dawson was THE Downtown Chicago Cadillac dealer at 630 N. Rush Street for decades. (Left)

The Dawson family saw the value of moving out of the city to Schaumburg where there was more room to grow. They also saw the value of long-time Cadillac professionals.

Ed Gesualdo has been selling Cadillacs for 46½ years, starting at Francis Cadillac on Rand Road in Mt. Prospect.

When Francis Cadillac closed, Hanley Dawson III called Ed at home on a Sunday morning and asked him if he wanted to continue selling Cadillacs for Patrick. Hanley didn't have to ask Ed twice, Ed was in the showroom at 9:00 the next morning and has been there ever since.



Ed not only has loads of great stories from his sales days in the 80s but he is as fresh as can be on the new cars of today, often dealing with customers armed with tablets and smart phones full of data. Ed just takes out a sheet of paper and lays out the facts in a way no computer can ever do.

In 2018, Ed was honored by Cadillac for 40 years of service; he said the award presentation was the only time in 40 years that he was speechless. (Left)

Ed's wife Andrea passed away in February of 2022, but he is "Papa" to three granddaughters and a trusted advisor to his Patrick clients. Ed is a REAL Cadillac Classic.
