

If you ever wondered about the origins of Patrick Cadillac, here's a bit of trivia from our own Elmhurst historian, Ron Schweitzer.

Les Bierk Cadillac was located in Elmhurst. Ron says he used to have his cars fixed there in the late 1960s. The Les Bierk franchise eventually ended up in the hands of Hanley Dawson, the Downtown Chicago Cadillac Dealer, later moving to Schaumburg and became Patrick Cadillac.




