The Grand National was Grand !!!

Each year that I attend our Grand National, I am reminded of the many friendships that have developed as a result of our shared interest in Cadillacs and LaSalles, and this year was another opportunity to meet new people and renew friendships with members of the CLC from across the country. The weather was warm and sunny and on Friday we were able to complete our judging before it started to rain. Our region was represented by myself, Fred, Dan Graziadei and family, Glenn and Valerie Brown, Frank and Elaine Link, their son Dave and grandson Connor, Mike Herbert, Rick and Vicki Kwarciany and Dan Leahy. Of course, the show field was filled with over 100 breathtaking examples of Cadillacs and LaSalles. Two of those cars were my 2012 Escalade EXT, which won first place in its division (Touring) and Rick Kwarciany's 1941 Series 61 Coupe, which won first place in its division (Primary) and was also awarded the Ansel Sackett Award.

The Ansel Sackett Award is presented to a 1941 Cadillac that is entered at our Grand National. This award was created in 1991 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the 1941 Cadillac. The primary consideration is given for authenticity and originality. It is named in honor of Ansel Sackett. Mr. Sackett spent his career working for the Cadillac Motor Division in various positions, his last being the manager of dealer development. He and two friends started the CLC in 1958. He owned many vintage Cadillacs, but his pride and joy was his 1941 60 Special.

Summer is finally here and our calendars are getting filled with car shows and cruise nights. There is no better way to show off our cars then attending some of these events. You never know who you might meet, that is what happened to me last year. I was attending a cruise night at a local church in Elk Grove Village with my 1989 Eldorado. A couple parked next to me with their old VW bus, the one with all the windows. As we discussed our cars I mentioned that my car had been sold at Patrick Cadillac in Schaumburg. That man was currently working at Patrick as a mechanic and knew the salesman that had originally sold my car. Of course, I made sure to tell them about the CLC. 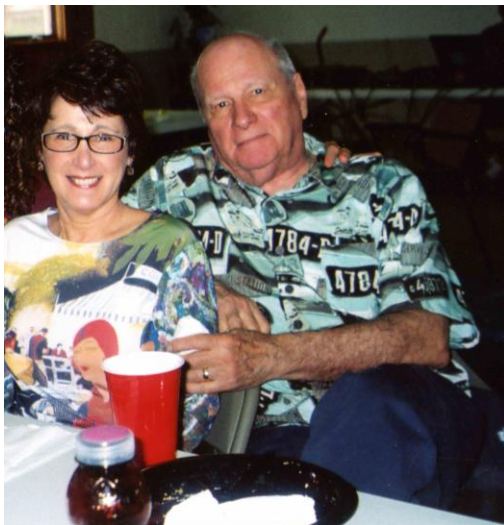

Is it a blue Seville?

George was my grandfather. He bought that car for my grandmother, Barb, and she loved it so much she hardly drove it. Blue was her favorite color.

It was that old Depression mentality that they had to save something nice. She always had a Cadillac since she received her first one from her dad when she graduated from Stanford in the 40s, but she just drove them on special occasions. She had daily drivers too.

The Seville was her absolute favorite car. I can't remember if my grandfather sold the car after my grandmother passed or if he still had it when he passed in 2016.

There is a lot of love that goes with that car. Those two were true lovebirds for over 50 years. Thank you for bringing up such a good memory. I asked my siblings if they remember anything special about the car and they both said they only saw her (the grandmother) drive it to Easter brunch and they distinctly recall that she would coordinate her outfit with the blue (color of the car).

Sorry we don't have any mechanical background information- just sentimentality.



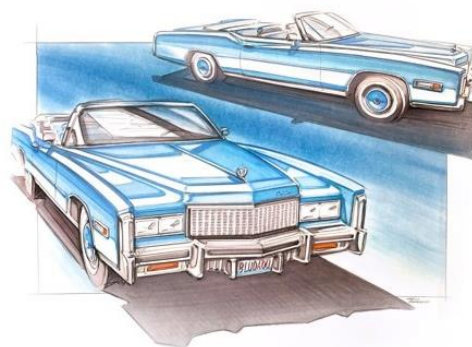
